


Scope of Services

In order to provide a current picture of customer's electric bills in northern Illinois, a survey will be completed to compare rates with the area communities of Batavia, Geneva, Rochelle, Naperville, and St. Charles. The survey will be based on the most current rates and the most recent production cost adjustment (PCA) or purchased power adjustment factor (PPAF). We will also provide a rate comparison for Commonwealth Edison (ComEd) and for residential customers on ComEd system purchasing from a third party (Customer Choice). The Customer Choice bills are based on recently reported median municipal aggregation rates and ComEd's distribution charges as part of its unbundled charges.

Monthly electric bills will be calculated from current published rates for residential, commercial, large commercial, industrial, and large industrial customers at various levels of usage. A sample of the Residential summer bill comparison is provided below.
